### Chari Dance - Rajasthan

Chari meaning Pot is a folk dance belonging to the Saini community of Ajmer and Gujjar's of Kishangarh. The women dance while balancing brass chari on their heads, along with a lighted lamp in it to celebrate a birth of a child or a festival. The dance is accompanied by sounds of dholak, harmonium and nagada (percussion instrument). This dance is choreographed by Bansari Hanna and performed by students of Shree Academy Of Arts - Vardini Subhash, Simi Nair, Smitha Nair, Soumya Vijay, Pramita Shenoy, Asha Sahu, Priya Iyer and Madhu Anand.

### **Gujarati Dance Medley**

GARBA is a community circle dance performed at religious and social events in Gujarat.

MATKI is a dance by the Rabari and Bharvad communities of Gujarat performed using pots.

TIPPANI is a dance by the women construction workers of Gujarat performed using long sticks.

SUPADI is a festive dance performed with 'Supadi' – a tool used to segregate grains after harvest.





### "Ashwini Sathe's Indian Classical Kathak Group

India is a land that is known for its vibrant culture, and among the many cultural staples of India is the Kathak dance. Kathak is a North Indian classical dance form, derived from the word Katha, meaning story. The stories told are all in the dancer's rhythmic foot movements, hand gestures and facial expressions. This performing art incorporates stories from Indian legends and epics, and the most famous and often told tales are about the life of Lord Krishna.

We are very fortunate to have Mrs. Ashwini tai Sathe bring this art form through her students to the Utsav program today. She is a renowned Kathak dance guru and artist from Mechanicsburg, PA and has received her formal training in Kathak classical dance from Maharashtra, India. With encouragement and blessings from her gurus, she has been teaching and performing for more than thirty years.

Ashwini tai has been very involved in the Central Pennsylvania community for many years as EC and Board member for HARI temple and AIACPA, not only sharing her talents but also volunteering and coordinating various and numerous cultural events. She is very organized and disciplined in teaching her students of all ages, following a syllabus from Pandita Guru Rohini tai Bhate's Kathak Institute in Pune, India. Ashwini tai also teaches Indian folk dance and is very passionate about instilling a love for Kathak in her students and wanting to pass this beautiful classical dance style to the next generation.
